This latest incarnation of our dance manual includes the following additional dances: Candida Luna, Confesse, New Yer de Tribus, Pontyplass and Sweet Nothings. There is also a new reconstruction of Fedelta. Corrections were made to Petite Rose, Lo Spagnoletto, and other dances. In order to make room for our ever expanding repertoire, most of the "Other" section of dances has been removed - you may wish to hold on to your earlier edition of this book if you want to retain a reference for those dances.

A time signature is listed for each dance near the title of the dance as follows
== In 4 ==. The right margin of the dance description lists the number of measures per step or group of steps. For example, in a dance that is == In 4 ==, a 2 at the right margin means that it takes 8 counts to do the step. The editors do not guarantee the accuracy of these signatures – if you notice errors, please send corrections to one of the e-mail addresses listed below.

In an effort to conserve space, but minimize splitting a dance between 2 pages, the dances in each category are not always in precise alphabetical order. Please consult the index if you have trouble finding a particular title. The Almans are listed in the order that the old measures are commonly danced when danced as a set.

In the index, we distinguish the reconstructor of a dance from the choreographer of a dance by placing a "/" in front of the choreographer. In the main text, we list the date and/or source and not necessarily the choreographer.

I: Processing: Line processes around room using 2 Continenze, 1 Double, 1 Continenza, always starting L. Repeat as long as the music is played for it. From here on out, use Pive.

II: The Snake Hay: C1, Ld leading Ly, leads to L, passing down & btwn C2 & C3. Once C1 has completely passed C2, Ld2 leads Ly2 to follow C1, like a snake. Each couple follows in turn, forming a long snake. Meanwhile, C1 continues down the line. Once C1 reaches the end, they stop, leaving room for C2 to continue between them & the end couple. Each "lead" couple does this in turn, until the line resets itself.

III: The In and Out Hay: Once the Snake hay is near completion, C1 pivots as a couple, without dropping hands, to face down the set. C1 goes down btwn C2, as C2 drops hands, breaks & moves fwd into C1's spot. C2 then Pivots to face down the line. Meanwhile, C1 has split, to allow C3 to move up btwn them, as they continue down the line. This pattern continues until all couples have been set in motion, & have returned to their orig positions.

IV: Circling: Once all the couples have been reset, and are standing still, Ld1 calls, "circle" & ALL couples take R hands with their prtnrs, & circle using 4 Pive. They switch hands & do 4 Pive in the opposite direction.

Steps for 16th Century Italian Dance

Bransle - shift weight slowly to side & back to center

Cadenza (Cad) – jump & land w/ lead foot slightly forward.

Continenza (Con) – A step to the side & close. Sink down on the ball of the foot as you step to the side, & rise up as you close with the other foot

Corinto - 3 reprises [or reprises sottopiede), followed by a trebucetto in same direction

Double (Doppio) – three steps, styling varies from dance to dance

Fioretto – kick lead foot forwards & to the side, leaping onto the toes of the foot. Bring the other foot across & land lightly on the flat of both feet.

Steps for 16th Century Italian Dance (cont)

Fioretto a Pie Pari – swing L foot to side & back, kicking the R foot to the other side.
Gropo - Trab L, R, L; cut R foot under left & kick L foot out in front
Puntata (Puntata Grave) - Step L. "Stab" R&Lift L heel off ground. Lower L heel.
Reverance (Rev) (lds) – move L foot forward, sweep L foot back, shift weight onto back leg with knee bent, straighten back leg back gracefully into standing position
Ripresa (Rip)– step sideways over onto the toe & lower to floor with weight on other foot
Ripresa minuta – “charleston” type step side to side (heels together, toes together)
Saffice – Sottopiede, followed by a Trebucetto in the same direction
Saltino a pie pari – jump straight up & land on both feet
Scambiote – Step sideways w/ lead foot, undercut, cadenza
Scorsi – Rise up on toes & scurry for 8 steps in 4 beats; lower heels.
Seguito Battuto al Carario – L heel forward, L toe back, close w/ a stamp.
Seguito Ordinario (SegOrd) – Caroso - three steps (for Negri, see Seguito Semicoppio)
Seguito Semicoppio – 2 Passi, & a spezzato (Negri - Seg Ordinario)
Single [Passo] – step lightly & carry through (do not close)
Sottopiede – step sideways, cut other foot under first foot
Spezzato (Spez)– 3 steps on the balls of the feet, with an undercut on the second step
Spezzato Alterato (L)– raise L foot & hop onto R, spez L
Spezzato Scorsi LL – Spez LRLR at double normal speed
Trabuchetto (Trab) – small jump sideways onto ball of foot

Galliard Variations from Compasso (*Ballo della Gagliarda*, 1560)

5-Step Basic Cinque Passi

1. In place.
2. Going to the side.
3. Going around the room.
4. Turning and going around the room.
5. As the *molinello*, i.e., one set turning over the left shoulder, and one set over the right.

Balzo (Bound, or Large Bound)

1. In quarter turns, with one beat per turn segment.
